DETAILS OF WORK

It is planned to drill an 8-3/4" rotary hole to an approximate depth of 150' where 7" surface casing will be set to shut off caving sand and any surface water which may be encountered. 6-1/4" rotary hole will then be drilled to test the Yates Sand at approximately 700'. If oil is encountered, 5-1/2" oil string will be cemented. If test results in a dry hole, surface pipe will be pulled and well will be plugged in accordance with U.S.G.S. Regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

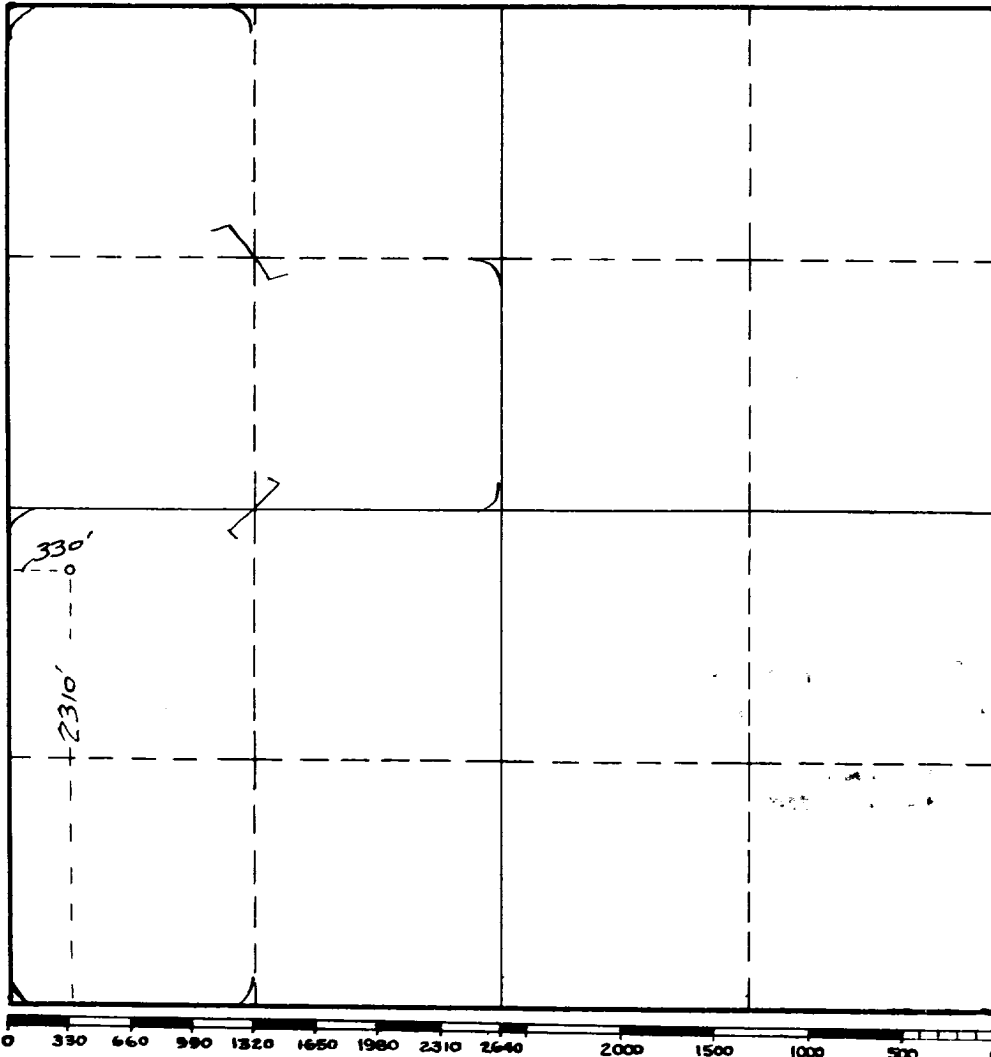
