DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate muddling jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Will drill with adequate cable tools to top of salt which is expected to be encountered at an approximate depth of 600 ft. and run 8-5/8" OD. Casing (24 lbs.) and cement same with 75 sacks of cement, the cement to be allowed 72 hours to set before drilling is resumed; then will continue to drill to an approximate depth of 2550 ft. and run 7" OD. Casing to a casing point at that depth, will mud said casing off securely to prevent any possible water intrusion into the hole.

In reduced size of hole, we intend to drill ahead slowly to and thru the various sections of the Delaware horizon which may be encountered from 2520 ft. on to possibly a depth of around 3500 ft. or to the big water level which is accepted as a marker for having reached the bottom of possible Delaware production.

As to cementing or possible lowering of aforesaid 7" casing, mudded off at 2550' will submit notice or obtain verbal approval to do so.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
