This test was drilled with cable tools by Kersey & Co., Artesia, N.M. to 3009 ft. T.D. and temporarily abandoned - October 17, 1951 -

We intent to plug and abandon this test. - There are 519.35 ft. of 8-5/8"-21# casing and 2577 ft. of 7"OD.20# casing in hole. Each string of casing is cemented with 50 sacks.

Expect to recover about 250 ft. of 8-5/8" and about 1400 to 2000 ft. of 7" Casing.

Will run string of 2-3/8" 4.70# of 100' tubing to total depth and fill hole with mud.-

Spot: 100 ft. of cement between 2900 to 2800 ft.;

100 ft. of " at top of 7" casing shoe; *steel*

100 ft. of " at top of 8-5/8" casing shoe;

and 20 ft. of " at surface with 4"x 5 ft. casing and steel plate as a marker

Clean up location as required.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
