Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On December 16, 1956, 524' of 8-5/8" casing was run to a total depth of 524' and tacked at bottom with 5 sacks cement and 1 sack of calcium chloride, to shut off surface water and caving sand and gravel. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours and on Dec. 18, 1956, drilling was resumed and a complete shutoff was obtained.
