FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At Total Depth 1548' a small showing of oil was encountered from 1461-67' and 1495-1500' estimated at 5 bbl of oil per day. On May 4th at 2:30 PM the hole was filled with 1 bbl of red mud to plug back about 40' and then treated with 1000 gallons of acid by Halliburton. Maximum pressure was 450# and minimum pressure for displacing acid in 7" with 60 bbls of water was 375#. Hole was swabbed immediately with an increase in oil. Tubing and rods were run for a pump test.
