FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Oil well exhausted. Now making all sulphur water. Total depth is 1461'. 7", 1452' cemented with 50 sacks; 8 5/8", 425' cemented with 50 sacks. Oil pay, now water, 1458-61.

It is planned to plug the well as follows;

Place 10 sack cement plug from total depth 1461 to approximately 1421, which is up in 7" casing. Bail hole dry. Knock off 7" casing and salvage same. (Theoretically 700' cemented and 750' to salvage.) Fill hole with cement from 1421 to a depth of 400 feet, which is inside the 8" casing. Knock off 8 5/8" casing and salvage same. (Expect to salvage about 200 feet.) Fill hole with mud to surface and erect marker over location. Clean up grounds around well.
