Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Stanolind Oil and Gas Co.

Company or Operator State "N" Lease Well No. 1 in C-SE/4 NW/4 of Sec. 2, T. 20-S, R. 31-E, N. M. P. M., Wildcat Field, Eddy County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The subject well was spudded September 13, 1944, and was carried to total depth of 2489' with cable tools. The reef line was encountered at approximately 2470'. Sulphur water appeared at 2480' and rose to 500 ft. of the top. Further penetration caused only a slight rise in the water level. We propose to abandon this well by plugging in the following manner: Cement off bottom water w/30 sacks, fill hole with mud laden fluid, pull 7" casing, set at 1560', place a 10 sack cement plug in 8 5/8" casing, set at 1093', which was cemented w/50 sacks, recover as much of the 8 5/8" as possible (estimated 800'), then pull the 10 3/4" casing, set at 330', and fill the top 10 ft. of hole w/ cement in which will be placed a 4" pipe marker to extend 5 ft. above mean ground level. The mud pit and cellar will be filled and the surrounding terrain restored to natural conditions.
