2516 feet to 2524 feet - Lime & Dolomite w/trace of to scattered porosity w/vertical fracture showing dead oil.
2525 feet to 2539 feet - Dolomite w/dead low gravity oil w/some fluorescence.
2539 feet to 2559 feet - Amorphous Lime, dense-no porosity.
Core No. 4 - 2559 feet to 2608 feet - Recovered 25' Lime w/scattered regular porosity w/show of dead oil w/trace of dull yellow fluorescence.
Core No. 5 - 2608 feet to 2629 feet - Rec. 18' dense Lime w/scattered regular porosity w/vertical fracture with some dead oil.
