DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

This well was drilled to total depth of 2962' without encountering oil or gas production and has been abandoned, plugging as follows. The hole was filled with heavy mud and cement plugs were spotted as follows: 40 sacks, 2962'-2820'; 35 sacks, 2330'-2230' (at base of salt); and 20 sacks, 940'-860' (Top of salt and in bottom of 8-5/8" casing). The 8-5/8" casing was parted and pulled at 495', and the required 4" pipe marker was cemented in top of hole with 20 sacks, leaving all 10-3/4" casing cemented in the hole. Plugging operations were completed 11-7-44 and the location is now cleaned up and ready for in spection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
