DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill Shell-Texas Grade Big Lody Unit No. 1-25 as a 7500-foot Bone Spring test as follows:

Drill 17 1/2" hole in the Red Beds or the top of the Anhydrite at approximately 700' and cement 13 3/8" casing. (Circulate cement to surface)

Drill 12 1/2" hole into the Tansill dolomite at approximately 2450' and cement 9 5/8" casing. (Circulate cement to surface)

Drill 7 7/8" hole into the Bone Spring at approximately 7500' and cement 5 1/2" casing.

This test shall be drilled in accordance with USGS Order H-111-1 of October 13, 1955.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.




