Reference is made to your letter of March 19 and our telephone conversation pertaining to an advance allowable on the above-captioned well, the purpose of the advance allowable being to allow Richardson & Bass to operate the well at a sufficient productive level to determine the productive potential of the producing formation.

Our Hobbs office is assigning the well a 55 BOPD allowable, effective March 13 (the date on which oil was first run to tanks from the well). In addition, they are assigning the well a supplementary 200 BOPD allowable, effective the same date, for the duration of March.

During April the well will likewise be assigned the same allowable, and in May and June we will assign the well a supplemental allowable of 200 BOPD in addition to its normal unit allowable. These supplemental allowables are to be charged against any future allowable assigned the well. Please bear in mind that the basic allowable and supplemental allowables are assigned for that calendar month, and any amount not produced this month cannot be made up the next month.
