Proposal to P & A submitted 5/4/65 and provisional approval by USGS on May 7, 1965. Provisions and hole conditions necessitated abandonment as follows:

6/4&5/65 Rigged up and tagged iron in hole at 1581. Unable to circulate. Set 28 sx cement plug from 1577-1500'.

6/6/65 Still unable to circulate. Spotted 40 sx cement plug from 1500 to 1244'.

6/7/65 Circulated hole. Had a small flow of gas and oil. Shut down to determine source.

6/17&18/65 Rigged back up, shot 7" casing at 880', pulled 3' and pipe parted. Screwed back on, tried to establish circulation. Unable to do so.

6/19/65 Decision made to shoot casing at approximately 1240' and cement to 880. After several attempts to get down, shot 7" at 1240'. Pumped 350 sx plug circulated 14 sx, leaving 336 sx in hole, 1240-865'.

6/21/65 Shot 7" at 744' and 425' and established circulation. Pumped 350 sx in at 865-93'. Pulled 7" from 425'.

6/22/65 Screwed off 1-8" casing and pulled from 33'. Found top of cement at 45'. Pumped 45 sx cement and 1 bag of fiber down hole. Spotted 10 sx plug at surface and erect p & A marker.
