

DETAILS OF WORK

Notice is hereby given of intention to drill subject ^{well}. Eight and one-half inch hole will be drilled from surface into the San Andres formation at approximately five hundred deep with cable tools. Logs will be run at total depth. If commercial production is indicated, four and one half inch, 9.5#/ft., J-95, BHC new casing will be run and cemented at approximately 500 feet. Prospective productive zones will then be perforated and fracture treated for evaluation.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
