On December 30th and 31st, 1963 well was bottomed at 1085' TD, and plugging and abandonment operations were performed.

Slight show of oil was encountered in samples from 975' - 1040', but no fluid entry until brackish sulfur water from 1080' - 1085' was encountered.

Water rose to 300' from surface and remained constant.

8-5/8" casing had been set at 388' with 50 sacks cement, and 8" hole drilled from casing shoe to 1085' TD.

Hole was filled with heavy mud.

A 30' plug of cement was set from 1085' - 1055'.

A 30' plug of cement was set from 390' - 360'.

300' of 8-5/8" casing was cut off and pulled from well leaving 88' of 8-5/8" cemented in well from 300' to 388'.

A top plug of 15' of cement was set at surface with 10' x 4" iron pipe marker cemented in well with 4' above surface of ground.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
