

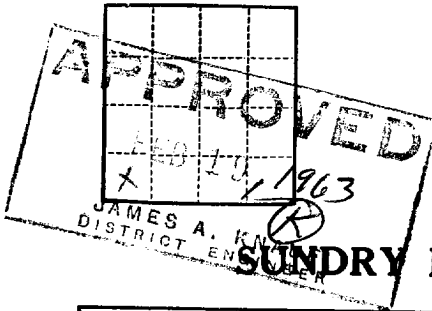

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill a 11,700' test to determine production and plan to test all shows of oil or gas to total depth. 10 1/2" surface casing will be set and cemented at approximately 250'. 8 1/2" intermediate casing will be run and cemented to surface at approximately 4,000'. 5 1/2" or 7" casing will be run to 5,000' total depth.
