Ran 1206' of 7-5/8" (24#, h-40) casing and cemented 1206' with 300 sacks regular neat plus 2% CaCl₂ and 1/4# flo seal per sack. Left 903' of cement in casing. Plug down @ 6:30 a.m. (MST), May 23, 1963. After 23 hours, tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes - no pressure drop.
