7" 23# & 26# Casing was set at 9522' RKB. A DV Multiple Stage Cementer was used at 7229' RKB. The first stage was cemented with 150 sacks incoer with 1/2 gal gel followed by 100 sacks incoer with 10% salt per sack and .8 of 1/2 Halad 9. The second stage was cemented with 150 sacks incoer with 1/2 gal. The casing was run and cemented Feb. 22 and Feb. 23, 1965. The top of cement was at 6850' by cement bond log. Casing was tested to 2000 PSI for 30 minutes after plug had been drilled and 24 hrs. WOC.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
