Original TD 9545', (6-14-64), PBTD 7649' (6-19-64). Set 7" Baker Model "K" cement retainer @ 7468'. Halliburton squeezed Upper Penn perfs. in 7" casing from 7552' to 7563' w/100 sxs Class H cement w/1% CFR2, followed w/25 sxs Class H Reg. cement. Max. Press. 2600 pis, Min. Press. 1100 psi. Reversed out 1-1/4 bbls. cement. Removed tubing from well. Removed BOP and installed Xmas Tree.

As stated in our letter to the U. S. Department of the Interior, Drawer 1857, Roswell, New Mexico, dated September 8, 1967, we do not plan to completely plug this hole at the present time as we anticipate possible use of this well bore at a later date for salt water disposal purposes. We have now squeeze cemented the Upper Penn perforations in this well so as to permanently abandon these perforations.
