After receiving your letter of February 4, we have reviewed the C-104's filed on the above described land. They should now reflect the following information:

The C-104's dated January 27, which we filed should reflect that the Upper Penn Formation is not a split connection and that gas and condensate are delivered through the Marathon Indian Basin Plant. The Form C-104 dated February 2, attempted to show a change of transporter from McWood to Permian effective February 1, 1966, for condensate produced with gas sold to Southern Union Gas Company. This form did not show that gas condensate was also sold through the Indian Basin Gas Plant and we refiled this form on February 8, to correct the
