Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 13, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Upper Permian and Lower Permian distillate from your Winston Federal Well #1 located in Block 1 of Section 31, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, Indian Creek Field, Wilcox County, New Mexico, allocating the condensate production to each pool on the basis of periodic GOR tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rules 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be completed in accordance with the provisions of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities, and provided further, that the gas-liquid ratio for each zone shall be determined at least once each six months.
