Your Notice of Intention to drill well No. 1-6 Federal "ID" (copy attached) in the 1/16 sec., sec. 6, T. 22 S., R. 21 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico to a depth of 1,800 feet to test the Glorieta formation is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations and subject to the following conditions:
