January 26, 1964

Rigged up and attempted to pull 13 inch casing from approximately 400 feet. Pulled collar at 72 feet.

Recovered 72 feet of 13 inch casing. Conferred with U.S.G.S. representative and received verbal approval to re-run the pulled 13 inch casing and proceed to run 9 5/8 inch casing.

January 27, 1964

Ran 2415 feet of 9 5/8 inch, 36 pound, J-55 seamless S.T.&C. casing (new) set at 2427 feet. Cemented as follows:

300 Sacks, Incor-Pozmix with 8% jel plus 1/4 pound Floccs per sack
987 Sacks, Incor-Pozmix with 5% jel
150 Sacks, Incor-Meat

January 28, 1964

Plug down at 12:30 a.m. Cement did not circulate. (Continued)
