9-26-96 - Moved in and rigged up pulling unit.

9-27-96 - Pumped 2% KCL water down tubing and annulus. Nippled down wellhead and installed BOP. TOOH with 2-7/8" tubing and sub pump. Rigged up wireline. TIH with junk basket to 7570'. TOOH with junk basket - recovered pieces of sub pump and cable. Rigged down wireline. TIH with retrieving tool and 2-7/8" tubing.

9-28-30-96 - TIH with gutless retrieving tool to RBP at 7597'. Unset RBP. Could not come up with RBP, but could go down. Worked RBP down and try to work up. Went down to 7692' and could not go up or down with RBP. Could not get off RBP with retrieving tool Suspect Reda cable bands around retrieving head.

10-1-96 - Worked tubing and got off of RBP with retrieving tool. TOOH with 2-7/8" tubing and retrieving tool. TIH with shoe, washpipe, drill collars and 2-7/8" tubing to REP at 7692'. Worked shoe on top of RBP. TOOH with tubing, drill collars, washpipe and shoe. Start in hole with overshot, drill collars, jars and tubing.

10-2-96 - TIH with overshot, drill collars, jars and 2-7/8" tubing to RBP at 7692'. Could not latch onto RBP. TOOH. TIH with retrieving tools, drill collars, jars, bumper sub and 2-7/8" tubing. Latched onto RBP at 7692'. Pulled up and set jars off. RBP started moving slowly up hole. Pulled RBP up to 7148'. Shut down for night.
