11-7-9-98 - Moved in and rigged up pulling unit.

11-10-98 - Pumped 75 bbls 2% KCL down annulus. Annulus went on vacuum. Nippled down well-head. Picked up BOP to install and well came in, blowing water to atmosphere. Notified OCD, BLM, State Police and Highway Department. Water blowing across Highway 137 due to high winds. Closed section of Highway 137. Stabbed a 2-7/8" swedge in 2-7/8" tubing. Hooked up high pressure 2" hose and began pumping 10# brine water down 2-7/8" tubing at 2 BPM at 400 psi. Continued pumping while waiting on Boots & Coats. Made up flange on tubing subs and weld ring gasket on bottom of flange. Boots & Coats did not want to install flange and kill well due to darkness. Continue to pump brine water all night.

11-11-98 - Picked up wellhead flange and subs. Removed hose and swedge from 2-7/8" tubing. Screwed into 2-7/8" tubing with subs and wellhead flange. Picked up off slips and pulled slips away from wellhead. Lower flange onto wellhead and seal off blowout. Pumped 100 bbls 10# brine water down annulus. Well went on vacuum. Bolt flange down and installed BOP. TOOH with tubing and sub-pump. TIH with packer and 2-7/8" tubing. Set packer at 7347' and tested to 1000 psi.

11-12-98 - Acidized perforations 7420-7896' with 7500 gallons 20% iron control HCL acid with 5 gpt scale inhibitor and ball sealers. Swabbed. Shut well in.

11-13-98 - Pumped 330 gallons 5-262 scale inhibitor and followed with 1000 bbls fresh water


