Your Notice of Intention to Drill well No. 1-1 Federal "PA" (copy attached) in the SW 1/4 sec. 1, T. 20 S., R. 30 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, lease New Mexico 04535, to a depth of 2,200 feet to test the Yates formation, has been forwarded to this office for approval.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, as indicated, on all types of lands and leases for appropriate action by either a Federal or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

CEMENTING PROGRAM

I propose drilling a well to approximately 2200 feet or to sufficient depth to test the productive interval in the Yates formation in wells to the north. A 12 1/2 inch hole will be drilled to approximately 625 feet or sufficient depth to penetrate the massive salt section.

Eight and five-eighths inch, 24#, J-55 casing will be run to this depth and cemented with approximately 400 sacks cement with 8% salt and 2% Calcium Chloride.

An 8 inch hole will be drilled to approximately 1875 feet and 7 inch, 20#, J-55 casing will be run to this depth and cemented with 50 sacks.

A 6 inch hole will be drilled to approximately 2200 feet. If the Yates zone is productive a Cal seal plug will be set above the pay zone and the 7 inch casing will be cut and pulled. Then a 5 1/2 inch, 14#, J-55 production string will be run to total depth and cemented with a sufficient amount to circulate.

All cementing will be in accordance with U.S.G.S. regulations.

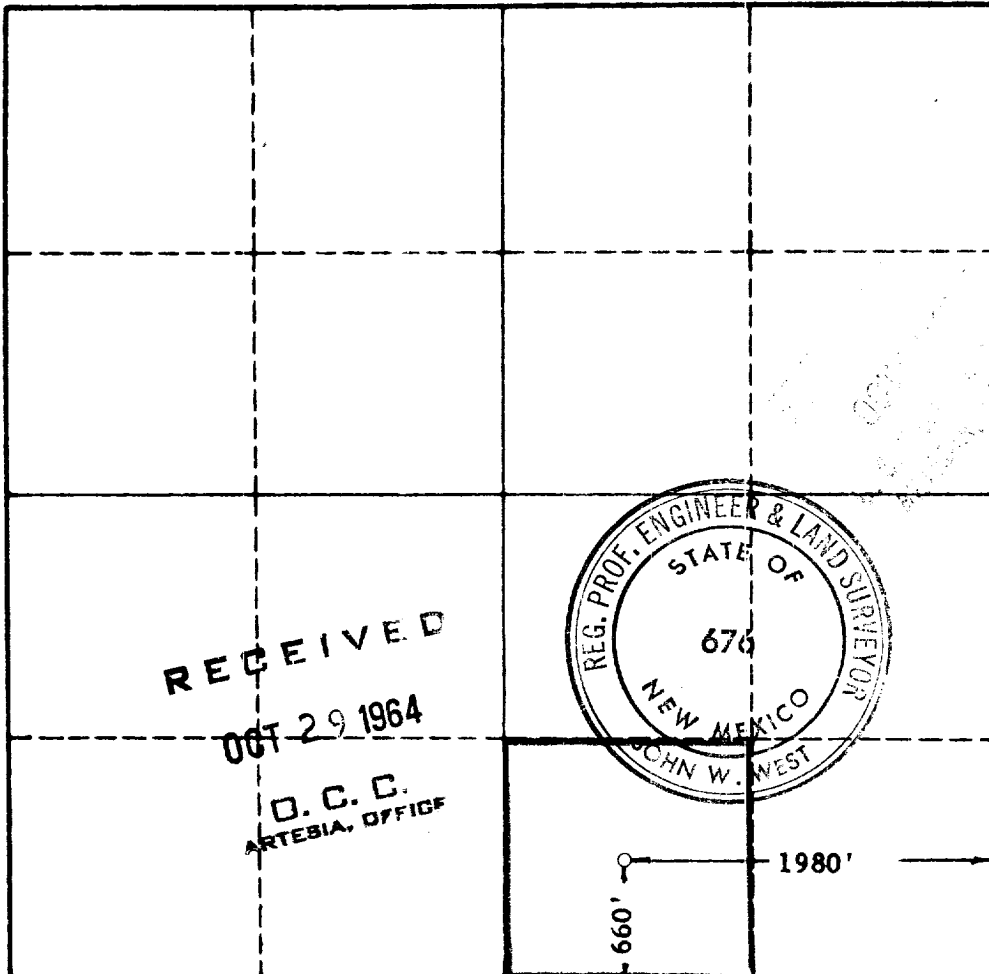
