On November 5, 1964 at a total depth of 663', we ran 661' of 8-5/8" OD 8rd. 24# J-55 casing. Set @ 663' and cemented with 300 sacks cement w/25# Gileonite and 8# Salt per sack plus 2% CaCl₂. Pumped the plug down @ 7:00 AM. Cement did not circulate.

We ran a temperature survey and found the top of cement to be @ 325'. We ran 3/4" pipe down the outside of the casing and tagged cement @ 318' and pumped in 100 sacks cement w/2% CaCl₂. Waited four (4) hours and tagged cement @ 141'. Ran 3/4" pipe back and pumped in 100 sacks of cement w/4% CaCl₂. Located top of cement at 50' and pumped in 100 sacks cement w/4% CaCl₂. Cement dropped to 50' in 45 min. Filled to bottom of cellar with gravel & caliche. Used a total of 600 sacks of cement. Job completed @ 2:00 AM 11-6-64.

The above cementing operations were witnessed by Mr. James Knauf and Mr. R. L. Beckman.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
