Dear sir:

Please refer to your letter of 3 June in which you request a notarized tabulation of all deviation tests run during the drilling of this well. This well was drilled with cable tools and there were no deviations tests taken, however the following statements are submitted for your consideration.

" This well was drilled with cable tools to a total depth of 1357'. We set 8-5/8" OD 8rd. 32# J-55 casing at 279' and drilled to 1357' with 8" OD tools. We had no trouble with the bailer sticking or hanging at any time. We set 7" OD 8rd. 20# J-55 ST&C casing @ 1341' in this 8" hole and had no trouble whatsoever getting to bottom with the casing."

" After the 7" casing was set we drilled from 1357' to 1419' with company reverse unit and set a 4½" OD 8rd. 10.5# J-55 liner from 1288' to 1419'. We had no trouble with the liner going to bottom."

In view of the above, we feel that the hole is in good condition and well within the 5 degrees allowed by Rule 111-A. Please advise if you require further information.
