We treated the above well with 126,000 gals. Dowell slick water with 3% acid and 70,000# 2-/40 sand.

Treating pressure 43-45 hundred psi. Injection rate 30-37 LPM. Immediate shut in pressure 3500# after four hours 1964. Ran 256 fts (8,023') 2" tubing equipped 2" X 12" seating nipple on bottom 2" X 5/8" Sweet production packer. Set at 8,023' with safety joint with LH threads on top of packer. Ran wash 4 times. Well kicked off. Now flowing gas and treating water at 100 psi. Tubing pressure on 3/4" choke.
