Your Notice of Intention to Drill well No. 1 Trigg Federal (copy attached) in the NW1/4, sec. 18, T. 21 S., R. 26 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico to a depth of 300 feet to test the Yates-Seven Rivers formations is approved effective May 31, 1964, date of oral approval, subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. A daily progress report is to be furnished in duplicate from spud date until completion of the well.
3. Drilling rig must not be moved from well without prior approval from the Survey (30 CFR 221.34c).

If the lease is to be considered for extension by diligent drilling operations, the lease rental must be timely paid.
