Spudded well 1:00 A.M. 5-29-65. Drilled 17 1/2" hole to 275', cemented new 13-3/8" 48 1/2 H-40 STAC casing at 275' with 225 sms to surface. WOC 6:30 P.M. 5-30-65. After WOC 18 hours tested casing to 1000 psi. No pressure loss in 30 minutes.

Drilled ahead in 12 1/2" hole to 880', drilled 11" hole to 2270', cemented new 8-5/8" 32 1/2 J-55 STAC casing at 2270' with 890 sms. of cement to surface. WOC 3:00 P.M. 6-6-65. After WOC 8 hours tested casing at 1000 psi, no pressure loss in 30 minutes.

Now drilling ahead in 7-7/8" hole to current depth of 3320'

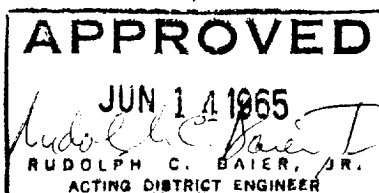

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.

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
