At a total depth of 10,230' KHM the following operations were performed;

July 7, 1965 - Ran drill pipe & conditioned hole. Set 50 sack Incon cement plug
from 9550' to 9670'.July 8, 1965 - Ran 8355.71' of 3 1/2" OD 8rd. 15.5# & 17# J-55 & N-80 5mls casing. Set
casing @ 8352' & cemented w/300 ex. Incon Foamix w/6% gel & 300 ex. Incon
neat cement, all with 1 lb. Floccule per sack. Plug down @ 11:55 a.m., 7-8-65.
Ran temperature survey & found top of cement @ 6450'.July 19, 1965 - Ran 7532' of 2-3/8" tbg w/RTTS phr. set @ 7416'. Perf. Wolfcamp from
7671 to 7687' w/2 JSTF. Tested spray of oil w/show of gas. Acidize perfs
w/500 gal. mud acid. Unable to recover any additional oil or gas. Squeezed
perfs to 5000 psi w/100 ex. Incon cement w/ 8/10% Nalad 9 & 2% CaCl₂. WOC
72 hrs. Ran 4-3/4" bit on tbg, tagged cement @ 7532' & drilled out cement.
Pressure tested @ 1500 psi w/no leaks. Pulled tbg & shut well in. Job
was completed on July 27, 1965.August 26, 1965 - Ran 7772' of 2-3/8" EUE 4.7# J-55 5mls tbg w/Octis "BM" phr set @
7709'. Perforated Cisco Canyon from 7864 to 7970' KHM w/2 Link jets per ft.
Finished perforating @ 2:00 p.m. August 27, 1965 & opened up well to air
to clean up perfs.

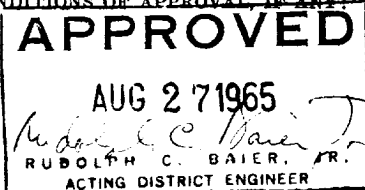

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
