Gentlemen:

By letter of December 31, 1965, your office transmitted Form C-104s for five wells in the subject pool to this office. Upon review of these forms we find additional information is required and we have made some changes of which you should be aware. The Federal IB No.1-D, 6-22-24, requires administrative approval of its 660.09 acre non-standard proration unit. The Federal IB No.2-F, 7-22-24, requires administrative approval of its 627.68 acre non-standard proration unit and ~~two notarized copies of the deviation survey~~. The Federal Azotea Mesa No.1-D, 8-22-24, requires ~~two notarized copies of the deviation survey~~. And, the Federal Azotea Mesa No.2-C, 5-22-24, requires administrative approval for its 692.88 acre non-standard proration unit and ~~two notarized copies of the deviation survey~~. Administrative approval of the non-standard proration units may be obtained through our Santa Fe Office.

Further, in compliance with Memo 2-65, attached to the front of the July, 1965, oil proration schedule, the lease name for the Federal Azotea Mesa wells No. 1 and 2 has been changed to Azotea Mesa Fed. Gas Com.
