Mr. Williams:

Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. requests an exemption from the Gas Well Shut-In Pressure Report for 1993 for the above well. This well is currently averaging 7 oil and 2984 MCF per day. Considering the well's significant gas production, if the twenty-four hour shut-in pressure test is conducted, both TEPI and the State of New Mexico will realize lost revenues. In addition to the lost revenue, there is the possibility of killing the well while it is shut-in for the pressure test. Swabbing the well back in would mean additional costs.

It is understood that if this exemption is approved that it applies only to the Gas Well Shut-In Pressure Report for 1993. It is also understood that if this well is shut-in for any other reason the shut-in pressure test will then be conducted.
