Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 2800'. Lost returns completely at 2520'.
As approved verbally by Acting District Engineer, ran 2792' of
7" casing -- 793' of new, 23#, J-55 X-line and 1999' of used, 20#,
J-55, and cemented with 100 sacks of Class A Pozmix with 2% Gel.
Fill-up calculated at 1873.51', or back to 918' from surface.
Due to hole limitations, unable to run DV tool for two -staging
above lost circulation zone, but in event of completion, plan to
insure plug above lost circulation by pumping sufficient light-weight
cement in annulus to fill to surface. Hydrostatic head of water after
lost circulation noted at 40', or approximately 1080#. 11.5# cement
expected to stand at 720' from surface.
Plug Down 8 P.M. 4/20/66. Started drilling plug 9:30 P.M. 4/21/66.
Tested with 500# for 30 minutes - no pressure drop.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
