17. DESCRIBE PROPOSED OR COMPLETED OPERATIONS (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. Set 9' of 10" Conductor Pipe at a depth of 9', cemented with 3 sacks. Drilled below 10" pipe with 9 5/8" hole using air, started mist drilling at 105'. Encountered first gravel at a depth of 115'. Gravel caved in badly which necessitated running 132' of 7" J-55, 24# casing to a total depth of 140 feet. After drilling out of 7" casing with a 6 1/4" hole 7" casing followed to a total depth of 150'. After drilling to a total depth of 160' 50 sacks of cement were squeezed into the formation in order to keep the gravel from caving into the hole. Top of the cement was found at 150'. The formation squeeze was successful and there were no additional gravel problems.

Ran 270' of 5 1/2" J-55, 14# casing and cemented with 15 sacks in 6 1/4" hole. Calculated top of cement 60'.

Ran 668' of 4" g-55, 11.6# Hydril Streamline Casing in 4 3/4" hole and circulated cement using 35 sacks.

Tried to pull 7" casing and it wouldn't budge, then filled void between 5 1/2" casing and 9 5/8" open hole with 15 sacks of Neat cement.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
