1. Ran 3481' of 9-5/8", 36#, J-55, Rg. #2, Seamless, 3rd thrd., short T&C casing. Cemented at 3479' K.B. with 1260 sack 1:1 pozmix "G" and Class "C" cement with 4% gel and 1/4# per sack floccle followed by 100 sack of neat cement. Received back 417 sack of excess cement. After cementing, cement level outside of casing dropped away.
2. Ran temperature survey. Indicated top of cement 450' K.B.
3. Ran 443' of 3/4" pipe and found top of cement at this depth. Pumped in 110 sack of Class "C" neat cement. Had good returns.
4. Tested CSO w/1250 psi - 15 minutes. O.K., September 13, 1965.

Instructions
