## Gentlemen:

Atlantic Richfield Company respectfully requests administrative approval under rule 104-D (II) of a 340.94-acre non-standard proration unit for the captioned well, said unit to comprise the W/2 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached form C-102. In support of this request, Atlantic Richfield offers the following information:

- 1. The Pure Federal No. 1 well was completed 2-4-66 as an undesignated Morrow producer from an open-hole interval 10327-47'. A non-standard proration unit identical to the one requested above was granted 3-16-66 by Administrative Order NSP-750. The well was subsequently placed in Golden Eagle Morrow Gas Pool.
- Golden Eagle Morrow Gas Pool was abolished by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 4838, Order No. R-4421, effective 11-1-72, and the Catclaw Draw Morrow Gas Pool was expanded to include the acreage formerly in Golden Eagle Pool, including Section 11, T-21S, R-25E.
- 3. Order No. R-4421 requires all operators within the expanded Catclaw Draw Pool to obtain acceptable standard or nonstandard proration units.
- 4. The requested non-standard unit consists of quarter-quarter sections contiguous by a common bordering side.
- 5. The requested non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental half-section.
