Reference is made to your letter of January 23, 1967, wherein you, as part owner, request authority to produce and flare up to one million cubic feet of gas per day for a period not to exceed four days from the Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 4, located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, to obtain reservoir information.

We are in receipt of letters of consent to your proposed test of the subject well from Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, operator of the well, and from Mr. John A. Anderson, Regional Oil and Gas Supervisor for the United States Geological Survey.

You are, therefore, hereby authorized to produce the subject well at a rate not to exceed one million cubic feet of gas per day for a period not to exceed four days, and to separate and save the liquids during the test and to flare the produced gas.
