We have your letter of October 10, 1966 regarding the proposed oil well to be drilled in Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 29 East, (within 200 feet of a point 1980 feet from the East line and 660 feet from the North line) Eddy County, New Mexico, to be designated as the Cities Service Oil Company No. 17 Big Eddy Unit with Cities Service Oil Company as operator.
