Marathon Oil Co. is requesting renewal of the Temporary Abandonment status of this well. The casing integrity was tested on 2-18-92 and witnessed by Mr. D. Whitlock. The well has production potential in the lower well bore which will be tested by 12-96. If no commercial production is found the well may have utility as a water disposal well. As development continues in the Indian Basin and Dagger Draw areas, additional disposal capacity may be required.
