Run 107 joints 8 5/8" 24# & 32# casing and set at 3238' with 1290 sacks lite cement with 10# gilsonite per sack and 1/4# flo-seal per sack and 200 sacks class "C" neat. With 1290 sacks cement in hole lost pumps on pump truck leaving 8 5/8" casing full of cement. Estimated 3238' cement between casing and 12 1/4" hole. Started drilling out cement 4:00 A. M. 7/15/70. Drilled out cement to 3258'. Ran cement bond log, indicated top of cement at 1900'. Perforated 2 jet shots at 1850'. Pressured up to 2500#, unable to pump thru perfs. Ran temperature survey, indicated top cement at 340'. Pump 68 sacks class "H" neat between 13 3/8" casing and 8 5/8" casing. Calculated 330' fill. Job complete 10:00 A. M. 7/18/70. WOC. 7/20/70 pressure tested casing with 2500# for 30 Minutes, Test O. K.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
