Spotted 250 gallons of 15% HCl acid from 2188' to 2557'. Perforated 4-1/2" casing with 4, 1/2" JHPF at 2425-27', 2454-56', 2492-94' and 2525-27'. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and set at 2547'. Pumped acid into formation at 1 bpm at 1500#. ISIP 1350#, after 15 minutes 100%. Swabbed and cleaned up. Ran rods and pump and placed well on production.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
