### Shutdown of High Pressure Gathering System to Artesia Plant

#### GAS PRODUCERS TO AMERICAN LIBERTY OIL COMPANY'S ARTESIA GATHERING SYSTEM

This is to formally advise that gas from the leases on the attached list will have to be shut in by 6:00 a.m. MST, on Tuesday, March 12, 1991 to allow for piping tie-ins and revisions to the high pressure gathering system to be completed. We anticipate all leases can return to production at approximately 6:00 a.m. MST on Wednesday, March 13, 1991.

Since no gas can be taken into the attached listed meters and processed during this shutdown period, any deliveries through our sales meters during this period will be deducted from the total deliveries for the month when volumes are recorded in the gas settlement statements. Any requests for variances to flare gas should be directed to the appropriate regulatory authorities.
