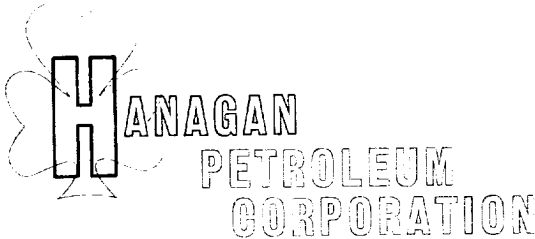

For each of the above captioned wells, please find enclosed in quintuple your Form C-104. Neither of these have been completed as to the "Name of Authorized Transporter of Dry Gas", "Address", "Is Gas Actually Connected" and "When". The purchaser of the gas from the Catclaw Draw Unit is Southwestern Public Service Company, P. O. Box 1261, Amarillo, Texas 79105 and the transporter, that is the party putting in the pipeline itself, is Llano, Inc., P. O. Box 1320, Hobbs, New Mexico 88240. It is our understanding that they plan to take a small amount of gas from the two captioned wells sometime in the next week or so.

With the above information (or any other that we can furnish if you let us know), we would appreciate your filling in the above mentioned sections of these forms with what you think is the proper information. Most of all, we wanted to have these forms in before any gas was delivered to let you know that some gas will be taken in the very near future.
