evidence of this approval. Upon completion of your Harris-Bell Well No. 1
in lot 8, sec. 5, T. 21 N., R. 29 E., N.M.P.M., as a well capable of
producing 1,000 barrels of gas and quantities from the Strawn, you are requested to
furnish this office with evidence that the District Supervisor of the
New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission has approved the 311.16-acre
spacing unit for the well.
