ARTESIA, OFFICE Stein-Federal No. 1 (Re-entry) 2210' FEL and 1980' FSL, Section 30, T-22-S, R-25-E, Eddy County, New Mexico

- 1. EXISTING ROADS Since the subject project is a re-entry of a previously drilled well, the attached map shows the wellsite and existing roads to be used. The well is approximately 10.5 miles West of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD There is no planned access road, as the existing road into the wellsite will be used.
- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS The location of existing wells are shown on the attached map.
- 4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES -
  - A. There is no producing well on this lease at the present time.
  - B. In the event that the well is productive, the necessary production facilities will be installed on the drilling pad. If the well is productive of oil, a gas or diesel self-contained unit will be used to provide the necessary power. No power will be required if the well is productive of gas.
- 5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY -
  - A. It is planned to drill the proposed well with a fresh water system. The water will be obtained from commercial sources and will be hauled to the location by truck over the existing and proposed roads shown in Exhibits A and B.
- 6. SOURCES OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS None will be needed.
- 7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the reserve pits.
- 8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES None will be required.
