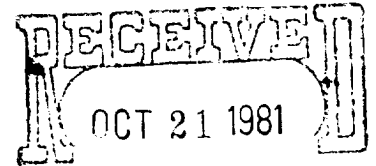

1. EXISTING ROADS - Since the subject project is a re-entry of a previously drilled well, the attached map shows the wellsite and existing roads to be used. The well is approximately 10.5 miles West of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD - There is no planned access road, as the existing road into the wellsite will be used.
3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS - The location of existing wells are shown on the attached map.
4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES -
 - A. There is no producing well on this lease at the present time.
 - B. In the event that the well is productive, the necessary production facilities will be installed on the drilling pad. If the well is productive of oil, a gas or diesel self-contained unit will be used to provide the necessary power. No power will be required if the well is productive of gas.
5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY -
 - A. It is planned to drill the proposed well with a fresh water system. The water will be obtained from commercial sources and will be hauled to the location by truck over the existing and proposed roads shown in Exhibits A and B.
6. SOURCES OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS - None will be needed.
7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL - Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the reserve pits.
8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES - None will be required.
