

Dear Sir:

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 8, 1973 in which you state that you are planning to drill a 12,500' Morrow Test in the Southeast quarter of Section 29-20-30 (your letter states the Southwest quarter of that section but in a telephone conversation with our Mr. J. B. Cummings you stated your request was actually for the Southeast quarter).

This will advise you that we will not object to a location 1,650 ft. from the south and east lines of Sec. 29, T. 20S, R. 30E, provided the well is drilled, cased and cemented in compliance with Order R-111-A of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and that we are notified sufficiently in advance of each casing and cementing operation that we may have a representative present to observe and assure ourselves that drilling, casing and cementing operations strictly comply with that rule as amended.
