We acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 23, 1973 concerning a proposed Morrow test on the property described above.

This will advise you that we will not object to a location 1,650 ft. from the South line and 1,900 ft. from the East line of Section 21, T. 20S, R. 30E, NMPM, provided the well is drilled, cased and cemented in compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order #R-111A and that we are notified sufficiently in advance of casing, cementing and other R-111A controlled operations that we may have a representative present as observer.
