Quintuplicate copies of Form C-104 for the Delaware recompletion are enclosed. These are submitted in order to obtain a temporary test allowable for the Delaware. During the entire testing operation a total of less than 400 barrels of oil were produced.

Please grant a testing allowable of 400 barrels to permit sale of this production. It is not anticipated that further Delaware production will be obtained.

In January, 1975 Inexco recompleted the referenced well in the Delaware Sand through perforations 4,096' to 4,106'. The initial results were uneconomic productivity.

Additional partner approval was obtained and the well was stimulated in April, 1975. The well was still unable to provide economic production. Large water volumes were recovered which were possibly from well killing operations.

In July, 1975 rental sucker rod pumping equipment was located and installed. The well was pumped until September, 1975 in an effort to clean up the water production. This did not occur and the pumping equipment was removed.
